Art News

Kyle Martin with Martin Gardner Architecture presented the Lowe Park Art Plan to the council. He explained the breakdown of the plan and how to use it as a planning tool. The plan breaks the park into areas based on the wants of the community. The packet will be used to solicit artwork for the different areas. The plan also includes a guideline for the process and breaks the artwork for each area into size and function. "Woodland Area" will be the first area and will begin the spring of 2016.

The Cedar Rapids Museum of Art is having free summer admission until the end of August.

Pat went to the Des Moines Art Festival and reported several of Jake Putnam's pieces sold at the festival. Pat also gave some postcards of local artists that were at the Des Moines Art Festival to Fuf for possible future exhibits.

Sculpture Trail Committee Update

Mike Carolan said \$116,000 is the amount funded for the purchase of artwork for the Sculpture Trail. The Marion Art Council will decide which area of the trail they would like to purchase artwork for. A committee will be selected to start the process and then a call to artists will be done. No timeline has been set but the Marion Art Council should decide in the next couple of months the area of the trail they would like to purchase artwork for and then begin the process.

The art exchange will be Saturday, October 3. The October/November exhibit will be the Iowa Watercolor Society Traveling Exhibit. The reception for this exhibit will be Thursday, October 15. Jan Bell will pick up the artwork and bring to the next exhibit in Clinton. The art exchange will be Saturday, December 5. The December/January exhibit is Julie Kulish and her friends. The February 2016 exhibit will be from Mercy and Cornell College. The March/April exhibit will be Barb Weeks-Caudill.
