a. Bill on Lawful Source of Income

Commissioners Nilles and Eiler spoke to representatives, Ashley Hansen and Liz Mathis to voice concerns regarding the impact of the bill. Commissioner Forsyth-Christy, being part of the association of realtors, shared that realtors are a powerful group pushing the bill and that argument for the bill is based on the association's property damage concerns, claiming uncertainty or no recourse exists to recover owners' losses.

Commissioner Rice in a meeting with Linn County public health director talked about racism and discrimination and how racism can be a health issue. Commissioner said that infant mortality rates for African American and minority families call for more investigation, suggesting the topic and inviting the director to speak on the issue next year.
