PRESENTATIONS

Presentation from Acterra regarding Tax Increment Financing Request

Nick Glew with MEDCO introduced Tad Cooper with Acterra who provided information regarding the project and funding request. Acterra is located on 35th Street and has been in business since 1958. Construction for the addition is planned to start in January 2021.

Council Member Harper asked about timeline of project. Cooper responded that the first phase would begin in January 2021 and second phase is planned to begin during the third quarter in 2021.

Presentation from Polymer Engineering regarding Tax Increment Financing

Peck reviewed the business operations and showed parts and products they create. Council Member Harper asked about target manufacturers. Peck stated the largest manufacturer he sells to is Kinze Manufacturing.

Update regarding Business Retention and Expansion and Community Promise (MEDCO)

Brady Quinn with MEDCO provided information regarding business retention and expansion. Focus areas discussed included community business climate, products, supply chain, management, market/facility, workforce and mental health. Emily Russ with MEDCO provided an update regarding the Community Promise program. Russ also provided information regarding the Pursuit Grant. Mayor AbouAssaly thanked MEDCO for all the work they do in Marion.

Discussion regarding the redistricting update to Marion Precincts and City Council Wards

Council Member Jensen agrees that option one makes the most sense for growth.
