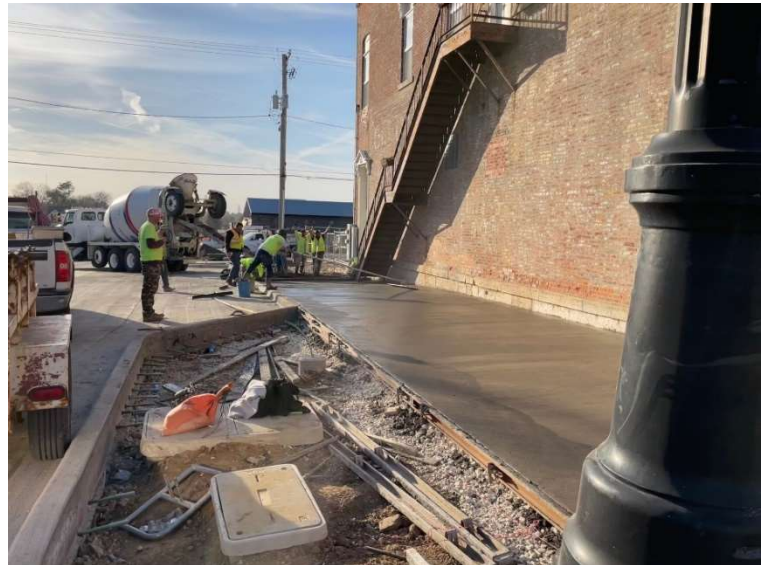
**Date:** Oct. 25, 2022

## **Recent Week(s):**

- Paving operations have been completed!
- Areas behind the curb were backfilled and the sod was placed.
- Pavement markings were painted in the final phase of the project.
- Streetlight bases were installed and wiring was completed.

## **Looking Ahead:**

- Seventh Avenue will reopen on Thursday afternoon, Oct. 27. Any remaining work can be completed with the street open to traffic.
- Streetlight poles will be erected.
- Brick pavers will be installed in the final phase of the project.
- The remaining trees, shrubs and perennials will also be planted. Perennial plantings will be cut down to grade over the winter months to help their growth in the early spring.
- Miscellaneous items will continue to be addressed over the next few months and may continue into the springtime as the finishing touches are completed.
