- Motion to approve the minutes from the July 18, 2023 meeting
   Moved by Godar, seconded by Rehn, to approve the item referenced above.

- Motion to approve the hiring schedule and accept proposal from Cayler Consulting for testing services for the Lieutenant position
  - Moved by Godar, seconded by Rehn, to approve the item referenced above. Fire Chief Tom Fagan outlined the application process including application period of August 2 to August 19 and then holding testing the first week of September.

The application period will be from August 11 to September 29 with the test on October 14. Commission Clerk Rachel Bolender stated Commissioner Kadlec is available to attend the testing. Commissioners Godar and Rehn stated they are also available. Kitsmiller stated the department is looking to hire three officers.
