- Discussion Regarding Firefighter New Hires
  - Fire Chief Tom Fagan stated nine firefighters will be starting next Monday and provided an overview of the academy that will be facilitated by City staff.
- Discussion Regarding Reclassification of Two Positions to Division Chief
   Fire Chief Tom Fagan outlined the item referenced above. This is phase one of the reorganization plan for the Fire Department.
- Discussion Regarding Fire Lieutenant Position

Fire Chief Tom Fagan stated there are seven candidates and the assessment center will be tomorrow and Thursday. A request for a certified list will be coming back to the Commission in October.

Motion to approve hiring schedule for Deputy Fire Chief

Moved by Godar, seconded by Kadlec, to approve item referenced above. Fire Chief Tom Fagan stated this is the start of phase two of the reorganization of the department. The application period will run for two weeks with an assessment center on October 2. The assessment center will be facilitated internally with external assessors. This opening is for internal candidates only. If there aren't any internal candidates, it would open up externally.
