1. Purpose

The purpose of the policy is to have a consistent permit process for excess size and weight truck permits to comply with Code of Ordinances 66.02 of the City of Marion.

2. Procedure

The operator or company operating the vehicle shall file for an Annual Oversize-Overweight Permit with the City of Marion. It shall be the truck operator's responsibility to have a copy of the permit for the applicable vehicle. The operator or company operating the vehicle shall have all other permits required to operate.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

The City of Marion, Iowa, and any other permit issuing authority assume no responsibility for the property of the permit holder.

During movement under permit, the permit holder must meet the terms and conditions of the permit and must take all reasonable precautions to protect and safeguard the lives and property of the traveling public and adjacent property owners. Permit issuing authorities will not be responsible for any damages that are the result of the move. Movement shall be made only when roads are clear of ice and snow, and visibility is at least one-quarter mile. A certificate of public liability insurance in the amounts of \$100,000 bodily injury each person, \$200,000 bodily each occurrence and \$50,000 property damage with an expiration date to cover the tenure of the annual over dimensional permit must be on file with the City of Marion, Engineering Department.

Nothing in the permit, except as specifically noted, shall exempt the permit holder from compliance with any load limitations which have been or might be established on bridge or road that is posted with embargo signs.

Permit is valid within the city limits. Anything outside of city limits must be acquired through the proper authority.

The permit and any revisions will be void if the actual weights or dimensions exceed what was indicated on the permit or its revisions. The permit and any revisions will be void if the total combined weight of the vehicle and load is 136,000 lbs. or less and the axle weights exceed those provided in lowa Code Section 321.463.

NO vehicle, combination of vehicles, or vehicles with loads that exceed legal weights and dimensions may be moved on city streets without a permit.

Oversize/overweight permits may be issued only for transporting a single article which exceeds statutory size or weight limits, or both, and which cannot reasonably be divided or reduced to statutory size and weight limits.

The permit must be carried in the cab of the vehicle for which the permit has been issued and must be made available for inspection at all times. The vehicle that the permit has been issued for shall be open to inspection by any peace officer or to any authorized agent of any permit granting authority.

Movement by permit shall be permitted only from Sunrise to Sunset. Movement allowed seven days a week. Except as provided in Section 321.457 of the Code, no movement by permit shall be permitted on holidays, after 12 o'clock noon on days preceding holidays, holiday weekends where holidays fall on Monday, or special events when abnormally high traffic volumes can be expected. These legal holidays include Memorial Day, Independence Day, and Labor Day.

The permit holder shall not exceed the speed limits specified by the permit.

Any reportable accident involving a vehicle operation under permit must be reported to the City of Marion Police Department.

One escort shall be provided for the movement of a vehicle and load which exceeds the roadway lane width or exceeds 14 feet on the city streets.

Either a properly equipped escort vehicle, an amber revolving light, or a strobe light shall be provided for the movement of a vehicle and load which exceeds 80 feet in length.

Maximum allowed for Annual Oversize/Overweight Permit. Any variation from these must be reissued on a Single Moving Permit.

Maximum Dimensions on the Annual Oversize/Overweight Permit, indivisible vehicles or loads not to exceed 75 feet length, 13 feet 10 inches height, limited clearances, 12 feet 5 inches width, 186,000 weight, 15 feet front end projection.
